Team Results: 4th Place – 71.5pts

The freshman attended the Millard South Invitational on Saturday, February 06, 2010. The team did well for the number of wrestlers we had attend, we came in 4th out of 17 teams and placed 4 out of our 8 wrestlers with two kids coming up one match short. Elkhorn had a commanding 1st place finish with 144pts, in 2nd was Bellevue East with 85pts, and finishing ahead of us in 3rd was Papillion Lavista South with 74pts.

We did not come away with any 1st place finishers, but had a couple finish 2nd place. Chase Sears pinned his way to the finals before being put to a halt by Kyle Fruedenburg of Norfolk, losing by a total of 2-1.
